

How to do Referencing (Citations)

Ancestor's preferred style is based on the Documentary-Note system which uses in-text note identifiers. Superscript Arabic numerals are used to identify the notes, which are placed at the end of the article.

Latin terms

Avoid 'ibid', 'loc. cit', 'op. cit' etc. for ease of understanding and replace with above referencing techniques.

Images

All images must have an acknowledgement in the following format:
